- The transition to digital-only TV broadcasting was a success locally, despite a great deal of national controversy. We helped prepare the community with a nationally recognized project called *Help Your Neighbor*.
- The price of HDTV’s dropped like a rock over the past year and WOSU’s HD channel was blessed with one of the most beautiful documentaries of our time, Ken Burns’ *National Parks* series.
- WOSU was proud to work with the Columbus Jazz Orchestra to provide the first local jazz concert from the newly renovated Lincoln Theatre in June. And we did it using a new fiber optic infrastructure at the Lincoln and high definition robotic cameras!

- More auto makers are providing HD Radio™ tuners in their vehicles, which could kick-start listenership helping WOSU serve new audiences. If you’ve already bought an HD Radio™, remember to check our all-classical music station on 89.7 FM – HD2.

- Online radio grew in popularity and will continue to do so. Online sites like *Pandora* were successful start-ups. WOSU kicked off its own online radio station: Capital City Radio...listen live at www.wosu.org/radio/listen-live/

- Social media exploded, of course, and we’re working hard on the public media opportunity of brands and a lexicon that barely existed a year or two ago: Twitter, Facebook, YouTube, blogs, etc. Please join our Facebook page via www.wosu.org and let us know your thoughts.

- On-demand is something everyone wants. WOSU’s local programming is now nearly always



available on demand through www.wosu.org following broadcasts.

Ok, so people are accessing media in lots of different ways with new digital tools. But let’s not forget the traditional radio and television stations. Arbitron released a report that says 236 million Americans over the age of 12 listen to radio in a typical week, equaling about 92.5% of the population, while Nielsen reported that 99% of video viewing in the U.S. during the past year was still done via traditional TV.

However you engage with or view or listen to WOSU Public Media, we hope we can provide you with the information and music you need and want in 2010! ●

Columbus Neighborhoods Creating Conversation. Creating Community.

Columbus Neighborhoods is capturing the history and culture of Columbus' core neighborhoods through the stories of the people who live and work here. Through the use of video, audio, and an interactive web site, we are exploring the cultural assets, surviving traditions, and challenges for the future.

Some remembered Count Basie and Cab Calloway performing at the Lincoln Theatre. Others recounted fond memories of days when going to the store or the movies was just a short walk away. These individual stories of the people, places and events all come together to create the unique portrait of a historic community that is being captured by WOSU Public Media, as a part of the Columbus Neighborhoods project Share Your Story events.

"It was exciting and enlightening to see people from different generations share their memories and to see their outlook for the future of their neighborhood," said WOSU Producer George Levert. Levert led a WOSU video crew that recently visited the Lincoln Theatre and Trinity Baptist Church in the King-Lincoln district to record nearly three-dozen stories from individuals that are current or former residents of the area.

"I'm so glad that people had the opportunity to share their stories, because now we have a record of those stories that mean so much to the historical record of who we are and where we came from as a community," said Suzan Bradford, General Manager of the Lincoln Theatre.

More Share Your Story events will be scheduled between now and 2012. Stories will be archived on columbusneighborhoods.org, a partnership project with the Columbus Metropolitan Library. Look for the site launch this March! ●

Jane Staiger Burns
1918 - 2009

WOSU lost a dear friend recently—Jane Staiger Burns—one of our beloved volunteers. After her passing, Music Director Beverley Ervine shared these thoughts about Jane on the WOSU Classical eNotes blog:



"I inherited" Jane as a then "FM"/Classical volunteer when I began working at WOSU in January 1986. When another long-time station volunteer, Howard Endter, retired from volunteering in the classical music library and in the business office, Jane picked up his hours and worked in both departments right up until circumstances prevented her from being able to come to WOSU any longer.

Jane nearly reached 25 years as a volunteer with WOSU...and she kept track of the anniversaries as well. It became a bit of a game for me to see if I could say something first about which anniversary it was before she did. She took great pride in her work and her relationship and service to WOSU. Without fail she had a smile for each of us, and in return, put many smiles on our faces along with many wonderful memories. She was a stand out as a worker and as a person.

Even though it was a non-paid position, Jane was the consummate professional—on time each week, impeccably dressed, and a perfectionist with her assigned tasks in our music library.

Our cataloging books are filled with her beautiful penmanship, so we'll think of her often with fondness and gratitude every time we flip through the pages as we search our CD library holdings.

May she rest in peace. ●
